Vikings

- Came from Scandinavia,
- Were polytheistic (believed in many gods),
- Wrote in characters called runes.
- Raided Europe using a hit and run strategy and regularly attacked monasteries.
- Vikings were the first European people to reach North America.


<u>Charlemagne</u> – <u>ALSO KNOWN AS</u> King of the Franks, Charles the Great

- <u>E</u>xpanded his kingdom and brought order to his empire by defeating many different groups
- Expanded education
- Supported monasteries
- Crowned the first Holy Roman Emperor on Christmas Day in 800AD

Feudalism

• <u>Feudalism</u> - A political/social system where a lord granted land and protection to a vassal in return for loyalty and military service.

- Lords were powerful landowners who used their land to gain the loyalty of the people around them.
- Knights were professional soldiers that received fiefs (or land) from lords in return for military service.
- The *Code of Chivalry* is a set of rules of honorable conduct that knights followed created by the Christian Church.
- **Peasants** were people in medieval Europe that worked the land in return for protection and land. They were made up of two groups:
 - o **<u>Freemen</u>** who owned or leased their plots of land
 - <u>Serfs</u> were tied to the land they worked. They could not leave it without the Lords permission.
- The *manor* was where lords, knights, and peasants all lived together.
- The *manor house*, *a village*, and *fields and farmland* make up a manor.
