




China's Geography

• Rivers:

The Yellow & The Yangtze

- Isolated:
 - Himalayas to west
 - Gobi Desert to north
 - East China Sea
 - South China Sea



The Lives of the Ancient Chinese



- The Yellow River leaves behind yellowish soil
 - perfect for growing millet.
- Farther south, there is warmer climate near the Yangtze River
 - Perfect for growing rice.

- Honored ancestors
- The Dragon
 - an all-powerful and kind god who looked out for humans by showering rain on a dry Earth ensuring a good harvest.
 - became a symbol of power.
 - Chinese Emperors embroidered dragons on their silk robes.

China's Technology



- Silk production
 - kept it secret from the rest of the world
 - More valuable than gold at one point.
- Bronze work
- The Great Wall of China
 - Built to keep out nomadic invaders from Mongolia.
 - Longest man made structure in the world

China's Government & Law

- **Emperors** had all the power
- Led by <u>dynasties</u>
 - One family ruling for many years
- During the Han Dynasty, the ideas of the philosopher <u>Confucius</u> helped lead the government.
 - Believes a good model for a government would be to model it after the family.
 - Taught <u>"the Golden Rule"</u>
 - "Do not do to others what you do not want them to do to you."
