

#### The Lives of the Egyptian People




- What they grew
  - wheat, barley, onions, beans, figs, grapes, & papyrus (paper)
- Traded for goods
  - Cedar, silver, horses, copper, cattle, gold, ivory

### **Egypt's Religion & Philosophy**


- Many nature gods and goddesses
- King = god Horus
- Afterlife <u>pyramids</u> = tombs, body and items needed, art would serve them





# **Egyptians' Lives Continued**


- 1st to build with stone pyramids, temples, Sphinx
  - Writing system known as:
