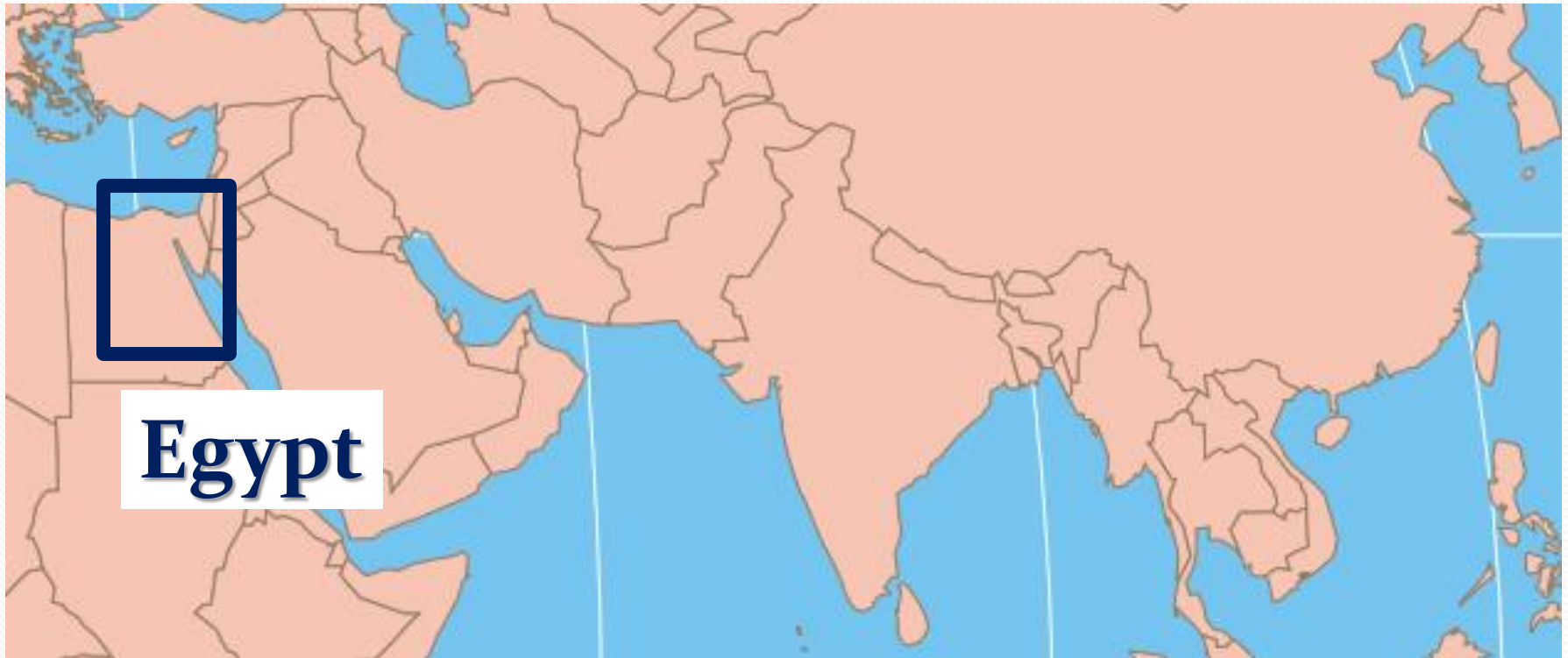

Egypt's Geography

- Desert

- Water flowed from the South to the North and drained in the Mediterranean Sea.



The Lives of the Egyptian People



- What they grew
 - wheat, barley, onions, beans, figs, grapes, & papyrus (paper)
- Traded for goods
 - Cedar, silver, horses, copper, cattle, gold, ivory

Egypt's Religion & Philosophy

- Many nature gods and goddesses
- King = god Horus
- Afterlife – pyramids = tombs, body and items needed, art would serve them



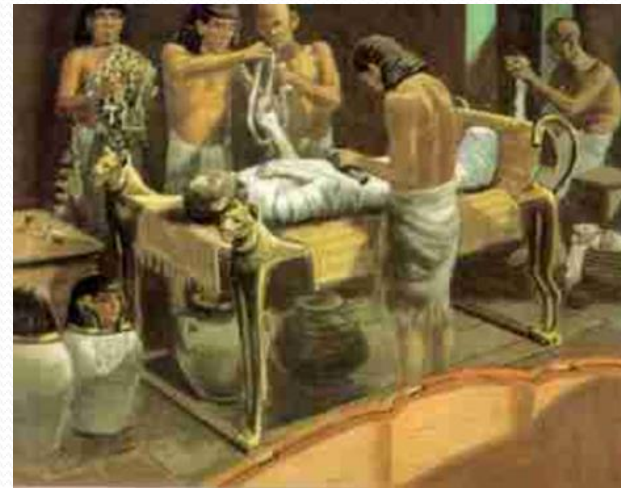
Egyptians' Lives Continued

- 1st to build with stone – pyramids, temples, Sphinx
 - Writing system known as:
 - A. Calligraphy
 - B. Cuneiform
 - C. Hieroglyphics
 - picture symbols, translated by Rosetta Stone
 - Scribes



Egyptians' Lives Continued

- Invented embalming (mummification),
- 365 day calendar
- Used math to build pyramids, canals, and reservoirs
- Brain surgery
