
The Lives of the Indus Valley People




- Farmers used irrigation canals much like the people of Mesopotamia to grow crops like wheat, barley, and a variety of fruits.
- They domesticated animals like cattle, pigs, sheep, goats, water buffalo, and the Zebu.


Indus Technology

- Well organized cities with streets that were straight and regular and neatly planned blocks
- Homes made from standard sized mud brick.
- Some of the city-dwellers enjoyed indoor baths, had <u>toilets</u>, and a system of drainage.
- The Indus River Valley people were the first with indoor plumbing!



Indus Valley's Lives





- System of weights and other measures.
- Traded with other civilizations in Mesopotamia, Iran, and Central Asia.
- People worshipped many different gods.
- By about 1500 B.C., the Indus Valley civilization had mostly faded away.
